How to refer a patient to the ACEMID Study

These are instructions to refer a patient to the Princess Alexandra Hospital in Brisbane only. Further sites will open in late 2021 and will require a separate referral.

What is the ACEMID study?

ACEMID is recruiting patients for 3D total body photography surveillance for the early detection of melanoma and other skin cancers. Participants are asked to visit our clinic for repeat 3D total body surveillance over a 3-year period at intervals depending on their risk of melanoma. We are looking for people with any risk type of melanoma including those who are either low, average or high risk.

The study has been approved by the Metro South Human Research Ethics Committee (HREC/2019/QMS/57206). The lead investigator is Prof H Peter Soyer, Academic Dermatologist, The University of Queensland.

Is my patient eligible?

Patients are eligible if they are i) aged 18 years of age and over ii) referred to the study by a doctor.

How do I refer a patient?

1. Complete the REFERRAL FORM on the next page. The referral form can be downloaded from acemid.org.au
2. Under 'reason for referral' tick the box for ACEMID study, but if your patient has a personal history of melanoma tick the High Risk Melanoma Clinic (HRMC) and ACEMID study box instead.
3. Either your practice or your patient can email acemid@uq.edu.au or fax (07) 3319 6965 the signed form.

Can I receive a copy of my patients' images?

If patients require medical treatment such as excision or biopsy they will be asked to return to their referring doctor for treatment. We will provide a letter with our diagnosis and images of the lesions requiring action.
